Anti-Bullying

Galway Community Circus is committed to facilitating a safe space for all our members and staff. To help our community flourish and ensure that we all play our part in creating a safe space we have outlined a code of behaviour for our Circus Space.

- **Respect for All** – Treat everyone with kindness, courtesy, and fairness, regardless of differences.
- **Positive Communication** – Use respectful language; no shouting, name-calling, or hurtful jokes.
- **Safe Space Commitment** – No physical aggression, intimidation, or exclusion of others.
- **Zero Tolerance for Bullying** – Bullying in any form (verbal, physical, social, or online) will not be accepted.
- **Inclusive Participation** – Encourage and support everyone to join in activities without pressure or ridicule.
- **Listen & Support** – If someone shares a concern, listen without judgment and seek help from Circus Staff.
- **Report Concerns Promptly** – Tell the Circus' DLP (Designated Person) if you see or experience bullying.
- **Respect Property & Space** – Take care of equipment, materials, and the activity area.
- **Follow Trainer Guidance** – Cooperate with your Circus Trainers instructions to ensure safety and fairness.
- **Be an Upstander** – Support peers who may be targeted and help create a welcoming environment.
- **Ask for Help** - If you don't know something, ask, if you need help, ask, that's what the Circus team is here for.
